

Privacy Statement

HARTING recognizes privacy and security as being a concern for most individuals accessing the Internet. Whether you're buying one of our quality products, or just browsing our site, we want to make you comfortable with our privacy practices and the security measures we take to protect your personal information. This statement discloses the privacy guidelines for HARTING-USA.com Web sites. Information submitted solely in a business capacity is not covered by these guidelines.

Please read our guidelines to understand the following:

By using our Web site, you consent to the collection and use of your information by HARTING as set forth in the policy currently in effect. If we decide to change our policy, such changes will be posted here on the Web site, so please check back periodically to ensure you have the most current policy.

What Information do we collect? How do we use it?

HARTING-USA.com collects personally identifiable information, including name, title, company, address, email address, phone numbers, credit card number and expiration date when an order is placed with us. We do not require this information to obtain access to any part of our public site, but do require it if you wish to place an order with us.

In addition to ordering, we may ask you for and collect personal information at other times, including by way of example, when you enter a sweepstakes or contest or participate in a promotion, or marketing campaign sponsored by Harting-usa.com or one of this business partners; when you want to find out about service offered in your area; when you complete surveys or other questionnaires; or when you send an email to HARTING-USA.com.

Our web server logs collect the domain names of visitors to our web sites. This information is aggregated to measure number of visits , average time spent on a Harting-usa.com web site, pages viewed, etc. We use this information to measure the use of our sites and to improve the contents of our sites.

Security HARTING places the utmost importance on protecting information transmitted via this Site and takes security precautions to protect all such information, including measures to secure and protect all customer-specific information from loss, misuse, and alteration. HARTING, however, cannot guarantee that any electronic commerce is totally secure.

Cookies and Other Technology Information

A cookie is a small file stored on your computer by a web site to give you a unique ID (each, a "Cookie"). Cookies help make it easier for you to use this Site and they help us provide you with the information you need - when and where you need it. Cookies enable us to store items in your shopping cart between visits. However, Cookies provided by this Site do not contain any credit card or personal information. HARTING may use cookies to track new visitors to this Site and recognize past customers so that HARTING may present more personalized content. HARTING does not use cookies to personally identify anonymous Site visitors. HARTING does not know who you are unless you provide that information voluntarily. With whom does HARTING share my information?

Except as outlined in this policy or on our Web site, HARTING never provides your personal information to third parties without your consent. HARTING shares the information you provide with HARTING subsidiaries and related companies. HARTING may also disclose personal information in special cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be violating this site's Terms of Use or may be violating HARTING 's or other's rights or causing injury to or interference with HARTING 's or other's property. HARTING may also disclose or access personal information when we believe in good faith that the law requires it. HARTING may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe our Web site to prospective business partners, advertisers, and other third parties, and for other lawful purposes.

What choices do I have regarding collection, use and distribution of my information?

HARTING may, from time to time, send you e-mail or direct mail regarding our products and services. If you do not want to receive such information, simply tell us when you give us your personal information, or follow the directions contained on it to remove your name from our mailing list. On certain types of HARTING promotions, we will ask for your e-mail address in order to contact you in the event you have won a prize.
